Course Supplies:

We will be providing all basic Art Supplies, that is why there is a \$15.00 Lab Fee.

- The art department uses this money for supplies used throughout the year
- The fee is payable in full or in installments arranged with the teacher
- Students' names will be added to the obligation list for non-payment and will not be able to participate in Graduation if left unpaid

We expect the student to supply:

- Black Sharpie Fine tip and Ultra Fine tip pens. These can be either separate or combination pens.
- #2 pencils, *not mechanical pencils*

Students should have these supplies available in class at all times. Because the Sharpie Markers are easily damaged if treated improperly we want students to provide their own. That way there is only one person to blame for not having proper tools .

Make-Up Policy:

Because the majority of our work will be project based requiring materials and tools, it will be difficult for students to work on projects outside of class. Students are allowed to stay after school to make up missed time on assignments.

Classroom Expectations:

I expect students to take responsibility for their education. I will do my best to teach, students must do their best to learn. To give this expectation some structure I have settled on the following guidelines.

Be On Task.

You will always have a class assignment to work on, or an ongoing standing assignment. There is always something you should be working on!

Be Responsible.

We will be using procedures for cleaning our workspace and organizing our work product. Studio cleanup will be a significant portion of your grade. It is your responsibility to maintain your workspace as instructed.

Be respectful.

Show respect to your classmates, your teacher, your school and yourself.

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Classroom Rules:

Specific rules for all classes in 3D Art.

- Inform the instructor of your arrival if you are tardy
- Sit and work at your assigned table
- Remain silent during Announcements
- Electronic devices are not to be used in class unless specifically authorized by instructor.
- Do not throw any objects even if you are just aiming for the trash can.
- Every student is expected to participate in daily clean up activity.
- Return to your seat when clean up responsibilities is complete. Do not loiter by the door!

Discipline Procedures:

Generally I will always give you a chance to correct any unacceptable behaviors.

If a polite request does not correct the situation I will be using our Choice Room in compliance with school policy:

1st infraction: Warning

2nd infraction: Parent/Guardian Contact and/or Choice Room referral

All subsequent infraction: Choice Room referral

Of course these are guidelines. You might be subject to an immediate referral for more serious infractions of school policy.

Course Grading Guidelines:

Weekly Class work Assignments _ 20%

These assignments will vary between creative and academic tasks. They will generally be able to be completed within a single class period

Studio Performance _ 20%

Your grade will be based on the following criteria:

- Unprepared -10
- Not Following Instructions -15
- Electronics Use, not resulting in dismissal to choice room -15
- Off Task -25
- Distraction - 25
- Choice Room - Any trip to the choice room other than tardiness. -50
- Did not Clean Up -25
- Absence -10 / Day.

This is a studio class. Being here and working on your assignments is key to this class structure. I will allow students to stay after school to make up missed time for Excused absences.

Project Grade _ 60%

- Each project will have it's own grading criteria that I will make students aware of at the beginning of any assignment.
